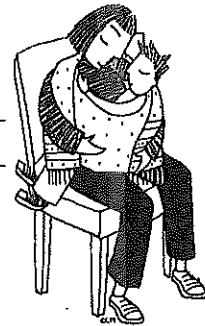

Today's Book Highlight: Pope John XXIII

John XXIII (known also as Angelo Roncalli) was canonized on the fiftieth anniversary of Vatican II in 2013.

This biography, written by Vatican II historian Massimo Faggioli, currently an assistant professor of theology at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN, offers a rich and insightful portrait of the pope.

The book includes excerpts from the private diaries of the future John XXIII, as well Faggioli's treasure of personal notes about the future pope. This biography offers a more complete and nuanced understanding of Angelo Roncalli.
